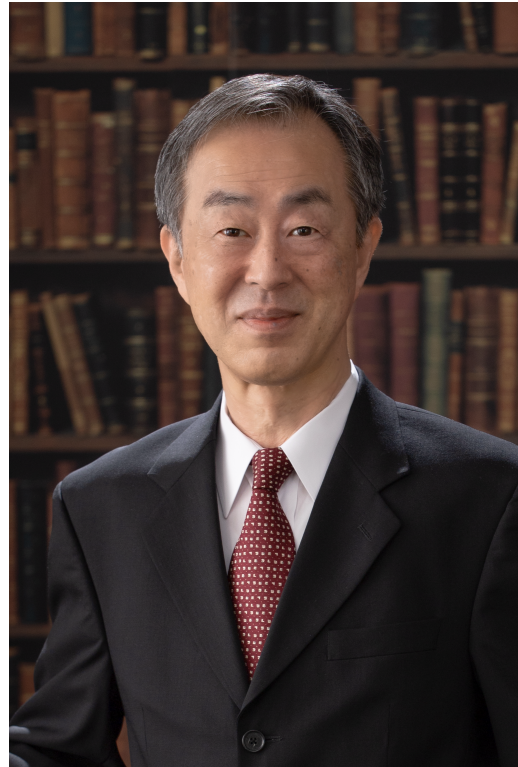


MANABU IKEDA

Dr. Ikeda, MD, PhD, is the Chairman & Professor, Department of Psychiatry, Osaka University since 2016. He has been engaged with anthropology, general psychiatry, neuropsychology, neuropathology, and old age psychiatry in Tokyo University, Osaka University, University of Cambridge, and Ehime University School of Medicine. He was the Chairman & Professor, Department of Neuropsychiatry, Faculty of Life Sciences, Kumamoto University from 2007 to 2016. His main area of research include neural basis of BPSD, late onset psychosis, and trial for pharmacotherapy and non-pharmacological interventions for older people with MCI and dementia.

He serves as a board member of many academic societies, such as Neuropsychology Association of Japan (President 2019-2023), Japanese Psychogeriatric Society (President since 2018), Japanese Society of Psychiatry and Neurology, Asian Society Against Dementia, and International Psychogeriatric Association (President since 2021-2023).
